



## Call for Application for Postgraduate Training Programs in Kenya

### Overview

In line with the Government of Rwanda's 4x4 reform and through ongoing partnerships with Elma Project, the Ministry of Health aims to recruit a Rwandan medical trainee to a fellowship program in Pediatric Rheumatology at Aga Khan University Hospital in Kenya. This initiative complements the maximized training slots in the Fellowship programs in Rwanda.

After completing the anticipated training, the Rwandan trainee will be issued a Sub speciality recognized by the relevant authorities, including the Rwanda Medical & Dental Council and the Higher Education Council of Rwanda.

In line with this, the Ministry of Health is currently accepting applications for the following training opportunities starting from 18th February 2025:

### Eligibility Criteria

1. Be Rwandan by nationality
2. Hold a Masters of Medicine in Pediatrics
3. Hold a valid license to practice issued by the Rwanda Medical & Dental Council at the time of the program commencement
4. Must not be enrolled in any other residency or fellowship program at the University of Rwanda or African Health Sciences University
5. Proven track record of clinical skills and growth
6. Demonstrated exemplary performance in his/her clinical practice
7. Fluency in oral and written English is required
8. Effective leadership skills and ability to thrive in a fast-paced environment
9. Flexible, with a positive attitude and willingness to adapt to diverse cultural settings
10. Female candidates are particularly welcome to apply to ensure gender equity in specialized medical careers

## Other Application Considerations

1. Candidates should be committed to completing the training in its entirety
2. Candidates will be expected to show commitment to work in Rwanda at the end of their training in Kenya
3. Candidates should anticipate being in Kenya by March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
