 - Familiarity with research elements to achieve excellence in teaching
2. Candidates must have an outstanding clinical track-record in the field of their expertise where relevant.
3. Candidates must present the evidence of contribution in both academic and clinical activities where required. Experience of teaching in a Higher Learning Institutions will be an added value.
4. Tutorial assistants must have completed their BSc studies with distinction (70% and above)
