Mu bitaro bitandukanye byo mu Rwanda habonetse abarwayi bake bafite ibimenyetso by'indwara na virusi ya Marburg. Mu gihe hakorwa iperereza rigamije kumenya inkomoko y'iyi ndwara, hashyizweho ingamba zo kuyirinda no kuyikumira mu bitaro no mu bigo nderabuzima bitandukanye. Hatangiye igikorwa cyo kumenya abagiye bahura n'abagaragaweho n'iyi virusi, mu gihe abarwayi bakomeje kwitabwaho n'abaganga.

Iyi ndwara ikwirakwizwa no gukora ku maraso n'amatembabuzi y'abantu bayirwaye. Ntabwo ikwirakwizwa binyuze mu mwuka.

Uwo ari we wese wagaragaza ibimenyetso byayo ari byo kugira umuriro mwinshi, umutwe ukabije, kuruka, kuribwa mu mitsi, cyangwa kuribwa mu nda, yahamagara Ikigo cy'Igihugu Gishinzwe Ubuzima (RBC) kuri numero 114 cyangwa akegera ivuriro rimwegereye.

Minisiteri y'Ubuzima ikomeje gukurikiranira hafi iki kibazo kandi irakomeza kubagezaho amakuru ajyanye n'iyi ndwara. Abaturage barasabwa gukomeza imirimo yabo birinda kandi bakaza ingamba z'isuku.

ENHANCED PREVENTIVE MEASURES IMPLEMENTED FOR VIRAL FEVER

Kigali, 27 September 2024

Marburg virus disease (MVD), a haemorrhagic fever, has been confirmed in a few patients in health facilities in the country. Investigations are being carried out to determine the origin of the infection. Enhanced preventive measures are being implemented in all health facilities. Contact tracing is underway, and cases have been isolated for treatment.

Such infections are transmitted through contact with blood and body fluids of people who are visibly sick. The virus is not believed to be transmitted by air.

Anyone experiencing symptoms such as a high fever, strong headaches, vomiting, muscle aches, and stomach aches should call Rwanda Biomedical Centre (RBC) on 114, or visit the nearest health facility.

The Ministry of Health is closely monitoring the situation and will provide further updates on a regular basis. The public should continue with their usual activities while maintaining a high level of vigilance and hygiene.
